INTRODUCTION

First «Cool Games» held in Ukraine in 2018. 550 schoolgirls and schoolboys took part in the first edition. They represented the teams from 24 regions of Ukraine and Kyiv.

The 1st ISF World Cool School Sport Games held in Kyiv, Ukraine in October 10-14, 2019. 64 schoolgirls and schoolboys took part in the first edition from Azerbaijan, Croatia, China, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Moldova, Ukraine and Kyiv. The live broadcasting of event and highlits you may see here:

Teams competed with each other in relays and active team games.

The program of activities of «Cool Games» includes 22 games and relays.

Teams will be paired and compete each other in two (2) disciplines. If the score is 1:1, they shall compete in a third (3rd) discipline to define the winner.

One School Sport Entity may enter the event with one team.

2. Travelling & Visa

Travel as far as Kyiv International Airport is to be arranged and financed by each participating country. When the distance between the host city and the capital of a participating country on another continent exceeds 5000km, the delegation may extend its stay by arriving one day earlier or leaving one day later at the standard daily fee. The LOC will have volunteers at the Port of Entry, awaiting delegations with signs containing the delegation country names and the name of the Event. Transportation from official port of entries to hotel will be done by buses. Delegations are to arrive on **09.11.2021 and depart on 13.11.2021** after breakfast.

The organisation of an extended stay for the delegation (before or after the event) is a matter for the country concerned. It shall not be the responsibility of the Local Organising Committee (LOC). Please check if your country needs visa to enter Ukraine. In case you need visa please contact the LOC ukryouthsport@gmail.com.

Current health measures

The latest measures regarding COVID-19 in Ukraine:

- All stores, shops, can work normally, from 00 to 24 hours, which means that there are no more restrictions.
- Cafes, restaurants, bars work till 22:00 (preferable distance between tables is 1.5 m)
- Measures concerning disinfection, wearing masks indoors and keeping distance remain in force.
- In transport – all seats can be occupied

ENTRY REGIME FOR FOREIGN NATIONALS

Due to the pandemic of COVID-19, LOC consider the safety of student athletes and all persons involved as priority. Currently the situation with COVID in Ukraine is improving so no quarantine is required from foreigners entering Ukraine. The regime currently in force to enter Ukraine is as follow:

- negative rapid test for the SARS-CoV-2 antigen (RAT, Ag) that was done no more than 72 hours before entry;
- or a certificate of a negative PCR test result done no more than 72 hours before the entry.
- or fully vaccinated person with the vaccine recognized by the European countries

Citizens of other countries need to have an insurance policy that covers the cost of treatment COVID-19 (the insurance company should have the representation in Ukraine)

SPORT ACTIVITIES PROTOCOL

- Wearing masks is mandatory at the medal award ceremony.
- The temperature will be measured at the entrance to each sports facility.
- The competition can be held with the presence of the audience in the stands. Every participant who is in the sports facility is obliged to wear a mask. Competing competitors can take off their masks while competing.
- Dispensers with a disinfectant (based on alcohol in a concentration of not less than 70% or another agent suitable for use on the skin) will be placed at the entrances, attendance desks, as well as at other key positions for the organization of the competition.
- Participants will receive a package with masks and disinfectant upon arrival.

Technical Details

1. Participation

The World Cool School Sport Games is open to selected teams.

The athletes must be enrolled as full-time students at school in the country which they represent. They must be attending schools which provide a general education and/or vocational education incorporating segments of general education.

All students must be attending schools which provide a general education. The following are not eligible to participate:

- Attendees of vocational schools who only attend a school as a complement to their vocational training and are not full-time students with segment of general education
- Students enrolled at schools which provide sports training without any general education,
- Part-time (e.g. Afternoon) sports schools which take pupils from a variety of schools for training in one or more sports.
- Teams formed as part of clubs, companies, or other institutions.

Participants obligations:

- Each participant is required to be present throughout the whole duration of the event.
- Each participant is obliged to take part in all the non-sport activities.
- Each team undertakes to compete against all other participating teams.
- Each participant undertakes to compete against all other participants.
- The absence of any member of a participating team from any part of the entire sport, opening, prize-giving and closing ceremonies and socio-cultural programme may result in the team being excluded from the final results.

The competitions of the Event include two different parts:

- ISF World Cool School Sport Games (ISF WCG)
- International Cool Games (ICG).

ISF WCG include competitions, where national teams participate.

ICG include competitions, where mixed teams from different countries take part. These teams will be formed during the welcome party on the first day of Event.

Each School Sport Entity may enter with one team (see REGISTRATION).

Head of Delegation (HoD)

He/she may not combine the function with the role of coach or another official role. He/she shall be the sole intermediary between the delegation and the Local Organising Committee and the ISF Delegate.

Additional adults

The function of each additional adult must be specified during the registration process (doctor, physiotherapist, interpreter, security personnel, ministry representative, media, etc...). Delegations can register 1 additional adult. Any other additional person not specified during registration or exceeding the quotas specified in this document will not be considered part of the official delegation and will not be accredited by the LOC.

*Team reserves - not compulsory – it is allowed to substitute the player of the same or older age (either injured or at any other reason, decision is under the HoD). Replacement is allowed only before the start of team meeting.

3. Technical Rules

The competitions of the Event are team events based on mixed system: group tournament – by means of all-play-all; Grand Final (semi-finals, third place meetings and finals) – by Olympic system with bowing out after one team loss.

All admitted participants of both parts (ICG and WCG) of the Event are divided by means of drawing into groups of the group tournament in the arrival day. The quantity of groups and stages of group tournament (one or two stages) depends on the number of participating teams and may be changed.

If group tournament will include two stages the teams that take the first and the second places in each group (WCG and ICG both) of the first stage go to the second group stage and divided into two groups by means of drawing.

The teams that get the first and the second places in each group or first-fourth places (if all teams will play in same group) based on the results of the group tournament, get into the Grand Final.

In semi-finals of the Grand Final – the teams that get the first place in each group teams of the group tournament meet the teams that get the second place in the neighboring group or the team that gets first place, meets the team that gets the fourth place and the team that gets the second place meets the team that gets third place (if all teams will play in same group).

The losers of semi-finals meet for the third place. The winners of the semi-finals get into the finals. According to the competition results, the team-winners are defined. Teams compete in relays in accordance with the program of activities of the Event.

Each team competition consists of three relays. Relays are arranged by the Head of panel of judges on the competition circles and distributed to the team representatives before the draw on the 18th of November.

The win in each team competition is counted to the team, that wins in two relays of this team competition. If after the two games score between teams is equal, then the third relay is played.

In groups after all qualifying rounds, the team with the highest number of team wins receives a higher place. If the number of team wins is equal, the team that wins in team meeting at the competition stage, wins. If this number is equal, then the higher place is by the team that has more wins in the relays. Teams that take 1, 2 places are awarded with cups and diplomas, team coaches with diplomas, team members with corresponding medals.

The teams that lose in semi-finals, play for the 3rd place and that teams among them that gets the 3rd place is awardee with the cup. Both teams get the diplomas and their participants – medals for the 3rd place.

4. Non-sport activities

“Nations Night”

Delegations are required to take part in an activity named “Nations Night” organized with the aim of encouraging exchanges between the different cultures of participating countries. Participation for each team is obligatory. The young people are invited to introduce and to promote their countries and their culture in an original way. Each delegation is to organise a stand that promotes their country’s specialties in terms of art crafts, visual materials, food, drinks (no alcohol), pins, leaflet, etc.

In addition, each delegation shall introduce a facet of its country’s culture on stage (with dance, songs, sketches, video, etc.) – maximum 5 minutes. The videos, music, CD USB sticks should be handed to the LOC during accreditation.

Administration

This event is open to the participation of:

- **ISF members:** ISF members are Schools Sport Entities members of the ISF;
- **Non-ISF members:** highest institution responsible for school sport recognized by the government of a country that is not member of ISF
- **Directly applying schools (DAS):** Directly applying schools can either be: 1) school not affiliated to an ISF member 2) school affiliated to an ISF member but not registering through this ISF member.

Please note that the "Registration" section of this bulletin is relevant only for ISF members. Non-ISF members and school willing to participate shall contact the ISF office (admin@isfsports.org and sport@isfsports.org) for more information.

1. Registration

Registration will only be possible through ERAS the ISF online registration platform (<https://isf-eras.org/>). No other registration system shall be accepted.

Phase 1 registration: From July 23, 2021 to October 1, 2021.

Delegations will be requested to state their intention to participate and exact number teams and athletes per team (boys/girls), coaches and additional adults in addition, the expected date of arrival and departure as well as the mode of transport will be required.

All countries are expected to pay the deposits for their team or to reach an **ISF agreement (see chapter below) by October 1, 2021**. Registration phase 2 will only be open after the deposit has been paid or an LOC agreement has been reached by the delegation concerned.

Phase 2 registration: From deposit payment/ISF agreement to October 15, 2021.

Phase 2 registration will only be opened after the deposit has been paid or an agreement with the ISF has been reached. Phase 2 registration: delegations are expected to enter the exact detailed information for each participant (name, date of birth, gender, photo, dietary requirements,

2. Fees

▶ a. Participation

In accordance with the rules laid down by ISF, the payment to be made to the organisers of the event will follow the rates indicated in the table below. All rates are per night.

The participation fee covers full board accommodation for the duration of the event plus competition, cultural programme activities and all local transport from the arrival to the official port of entry to the departure of the team.

▶ b. ISF Levy

An additional ISF levy per delegation member must be paid together with the balance of the participation fee.

- **40€ for ISF members**
- **100€ for non ISF members**
- **100€ for Directly applying schools**

c. Gala Dinner

A charity gala dinner is organised during the event. All Heads of Delegation are expected to take part in the dinner; in addition, all adults in the delegation can attend, upon registration through the ERAS system. The gala dinner fee is 50€/person, to be paid together with the final balance.

d. Final Balance

The table below shows an overview of the minimum total event fee per participant for ISF members:

The final balance is to be paid on arrival in cash or in advance by bank transfer.

3. Deposit

Along with the entry and in order to have access to the second registration phase, participating countries will need to pay a deposit of 1000€ per team entered. The sum will be deducted from the total participation cost.

The deposit is non-refundable in the event of non-participation. Waivers to the payment of the deposit (ISF agreement), for whatever reasons, are to be discussed with the ISF and to be agreed by the deposit payment deadlines. In case of cancellation of the event, and in case of restrictive travel measures imposed by national governments in relation to COVID-19, the deposit will be fully refunded.

4. Insurance

Each country is required to provide insurance for each member of its delegation. At a minimum the insurance is to cover civil liability, material damage and medical costs.



USEFUL INFORMATION

Ukraine is a country in Eastern Europe. Ukraine has a population of about 42.5 million, making it the 32nd most populous country in the world. Its capital and largest city is Kyiv.

- **Language:** Ukrainian
 - **Currency:** Gryvna (UAH) ; 1 euro = 29 UAH ;
 - Credit cards are acceptable in the shops, malls, restaurants – cash mostly at the bars
 - Temperature - Daytime maximum temperatures average around 0°C, at night -8°C is normal.
 - **Electrical socket:** In Ukraine the power plugs and sockets are of the following type C and F (220 V and 50 Hz)
